



As per the Saskatchewan Hockey Association's face covering policy. In the AGT Community Centre face coverings are required to be worn by anyone over the age of 2 years old. This includes coaches, bench staff, on ice officials, off ice officials, parents, and spectators.

#### Players:

- Players must be properly wearing a face covering when entering the AGT Community Centre and continue wearing it until they are ready to put on their helmet.
- Players must put their face covering back on once they remove their helmet.
- Players should exercise physical distancing while entering and exiting arenas and while putting on their equipment.

#### On Ice Coaches:

- Must wear a face covering when entering the AGT Community Centre and continue wearing it until they are ready to put on their helmet.
- Are not required to wear a face covering while on the ice. They should carry one with them in case they need to be closer to a player or fellow coach.
- Should put their face covering back on as soon as they remove their helmet.
- Should exercise physical distancing while entering and exiting the AGT Community Centre.

#### Bench Coaches

- Must always wear a face covering when entering and exiting the arena and continue to wear it including while on the bench during games.
- Should exercise physical distancing while entering and exiting the AGT Community Centre.

#### Off Ice Officials

- Must wear a face covering when entering the AGT Community Centre and continue wearing it while in the timekeeper's box as much as possible.
- Should exercise physical distancing while entering and exiting the AGT Community Centre.

#### Parents/Spectators

- Must always wear a face covering while in the AGT Community Centre
- Should exercise physical distancing while entering and exiting the AGT Community Centre and while sitting in the stands or in the lobby.

#### General

- Please arrive no earlier than 20 minutes before your scheduled ice time
- Players are to remain in their dressing rooms until it is time to go on the ice. Players are not to line up at the doors to get on to the ice while waiting.
- Everyone is asked to leave the AGT Community Centre 15 minutes after the end of their ice time.
- Children must always remain seated with their parents. No running around the rink.
- Spectators are strongly discouraged from congregating in the lobby.
- Spectators should not be permitted in the dressing rooms, players bench or on the ice surface unless it is deemed necessary.
