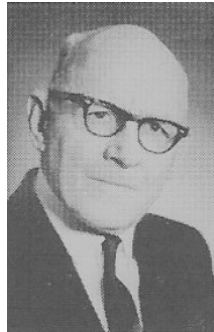

Honouring 100 years of medical practice in Eston and area.



Dr. Holmes' father, Dr. Samuel Holmes, M.D., L.M.C.C., took up a medical practice in Eston in 1930 and served the community until his retirement in 1969.

Dr. Stewart Holmes followed in his father's footsteps after attending the University of Manitoba. He graduated in June, 1955

and in September of that year started practicing medicine in Eston with his father.

In 1995, Dr. Stewart Holmes became a lifetime member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan.

In 2005, he was honoured to be named the Physician of the Year for Saskatchewan by the Saskatchewan Medical Association.

Over the past several years, Dr. Holmes has taken part as a JURSI preceptor in the Clinical Teaching program for the Department of Academic Family Medicine, University of Saskatchewan.

In the fall of 2010, he was presented with a 55 year Service Award from the Heartland Health Region.

In 2011, he was awarded an Honorary Membership in the Canadian Medical Association in recognition of his contribution to the medical profession.

Dr. Holmes retired from his medical practice on July 7, 2014 (his 86th birthday) but continues as an advisor and trustee to the Eston & District Medical Centre.

The Dr. Stewart Holmes Scholarships were introduced in 1985 in honour of Dr. Stewart Holmes of Eston, his contribution in the health care field and to encourage and promote post-secondary education in health care.

In 29 years since inception, 135 Dr. Stewart Holmes Scholarships have been given to people of various ages entering the many facets of health care.

Any student who is from the Dr. Holmes' former practice area and has been accepted into a full time program in a health care field at a university or technical institute is eligible to apply for a Dr. Stewart Holmes Scholarship.

The Dr. Holmes' former practice area is bordered by the South Saskatchewan River on the south, Eatonia on the west, Elrose on the east and the #7 Highway in the north. It includes the communities of Brock, Eatonia, Elrose, Eston, Kindersley and Kyle.

The Dr. Stewart Holmes Scholarship Fund was established to honour Dr. Holmes and to "Honour young people, and help young people with education in the medical field."
